Students Seminar Mechanism

Purpose

Seminar is an instructional technique of higher learning which involves generating a situation for a group to have guided interaction among themselves on different aspects or components of a topic, which is generally presented by one or more members with a purpose to bring together all students (B.Ed & M.Ed) to discuss ideas & goals towards developing an inviting & thriving education sector in which the education would complement one another.

Aims & Objectives-

- To develop the self confidence in students.
- To develop the Leadership quality.
- To develop the inner potential of students.
- To develop teaching skills.
- To increase the quality of learning by students.

Rules & Responsibilities

- Each Seminar will last upto for atleast 10-15 minutes.
- It is Compulsory for all the students to be present in seminar hall during its conduction.
- Students presenting seminar should be with both hard copy and soft copy of the seminar during its presentation.
- All the topics will be from the part of the curriculum thus no changes in the topic will be entertained.

Mechanisn /Procedure-

- Seminar of Departments are organized in every session. Seminar Incharge give presentation to the students and give information about seminar and also discuss rules, regulation and importance of seminar.
- Seminar is organized after 15 days of session starting, in this method first of all topics is being
 collected from the subject teachers & than distributed to the randomly selected group of the students.
- Before ten day prior notice of seminar topic with corresponding students is displayed these topics are displayed continuously till the semester is completed. Two groups are allowed to give seminar presentation on 1 days. Each group has 2 students and each seminar is held for 20minutes, 2 days of a week are allotted for seminar(B.Ed & M.Ed).
- Before one day of seminar duty of teachers is imposed by the seminar incharge in the notice register.
- After the seminar completion it is cross-questioned and inspected by the Teachers & proper guidance
 is provided. Students attending the seminar are also asked to cross-question about the topic then
 students have to submit hard copy & soft copy related to their seminar presentation. At least 3
 Teachers should be present in each seminar to approve it.

Expected Outcome:

- Students will be able to show competence in identifying relevant information, defining and explaining topics under discussion.
- Students will be able to judge when to speak and how much to say, speak clearly and audibly in a manner appropriate to the subject, ask appropriate questions, use evidence to support claims
- They will be able to follow academic discussions, infer meanings that are not overt, and take notes from a discussion or presentation.
- Through asking appropriate questions, students will demonstrate their understanding of discussions and spark further discussion.
- Students will engage with works that are widely held to be significant in the field of study.
